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WINTER YOUTH PROGRAMS

APPLICATION TO PARTICIPATE

The Recreation and Parks Association of Nunavut (RPAN), is pleased to once again be hosting our Winter Youth Programs including: NU Moves After School Program, Christmas Games, and the Winter Camp Week program. The Winter Camps will be hosted during PD week in February, using a day camp format.

Training youth leaders (15 – 29 years) will be hosted in a “blended” approach through in person and zoom training, starting in early November 2023. Communities will receive wage support for up to three youth leaders based on minimum wage.

Purpose and Objectives

The purpose of this project is to provide support and training to communities in the Nunavut for the successful implementation of various winter programs for children ages 5 – 12 years. This includes providing training and resources to youth leaders, as well as equipment, craft supplies and resource materials.

The project objectives include:

- ✓ Provide training to support communities hosting winter programs;
- ✓ Provide casual winter employment;
- ✓ Provide quality winter programs for children and youth;
- ✓ Develop effective partnerships with those currently providing services in the community related to youth.
- ✓ Provide resources necessary for the implementation of winter programs;
- ✓ Provide equipment and supplies needed to deliver successful programs.

WINTER YOUTH PROGRAM INFORMATION

HOW DO COMMUNITIES BECOME INVOLVED IN THE WINTER YOUTH PROGRAMS?

- Communities will need to be in good standing with RPAN;
- Application and support letter for the Winter Youth Programs must be received by **September 08th, 2023**;
- Confirmation of space for Winter Youth Program use must be included in the letter;
- **All** winter youth staff 18 years and older will need to have a CRC/VSC, and youth leaders under 18 years will need to have a VSC by **November 01st, 2023**;
- Attend training session in Winnipeg in November
- Attend all zoom training and meetings.

Hamlet MUST be in good standing with RPAN...any Hamlets owing program reports, fees or other monies will not be considered for participation until paid in full. Hamlets MUST be RPAN members for the April 2023 – March 2024 year.



WHAT SUPPORT CAN HAMLETS EXPECT FROM RPAN WITH LTW WINTER YOUTH PROGRAMS?

RPAN WILL...

- ✓ cover 100% of all training costs including: travel, accommodations, food, (for up to 4 people per community – 3 youth leaders and one recreation coordinator/program supervisor)
- ✓ purchase art and craft supplies for each community
- ✓ provide support to each community for snacks and drinks
- ✓ provide participant t-shirts for each community
- ✓ provide staff clothing
- ✓ provide all resources to participating communities
- ✓ provide and or replenish equipment
- ✓ Reimburse wage money based on agreement signed once approved to participate in program. Wage reimbursement will be provided for up to three youth leaders based on \$16/hr plus mercs.

HAMLETS WILL...

- ✓ Recruit and hire winter youth program staff
- ✓ Allocate a suitable space to host all winter programs (community hall, arena, etc)
- ✓ Ensure youth leaders are provided support from Recreation Coordinator during program implementation (recreation coordinators do NOT need to be working the programs, just available for support)
- ✓ Pay for wages and submit report and invoice for reimbursement from RPAN as per agreement.
